

# INTRODUCTION

Here at Eastleigh we have a small friendly group of healers working within the church and we would like to thank you for expressing an interest in becoming a trainee with the group.

If after you have read this leaflet you are still interested, have a chat with the healing group leader who can arrange to have an informal meeting with you to discuss your interest in healing.

We will discuss the induction course, which is a six week induction process and will cover:

- Teachings and philosophy of Spiritualism
- Relaxation and visualisation
- Attunement
- Healing methods
- Discussion and demonstration of hands on healing
- Contents of the H1- Basic Healing Course, SNU Class B Membership, practical training sessions, Code of Conduct and Healing and the law, upgrading to approved healer, costs and fees.

If after the induction period you wish to join the healing group and start your training, you must meet the criteria laid out by the SNU Healing Committee, (covered within this leaflet) and depending on how many trainees are already in the healing group, the healing group leader will either put your name upon the waiting list to join the group or propose to the church committee that you join the healing group and be registered with the SNU Healing Committee.

If the church committee accept the healing leaders proposal to enrol you on the course, you will be invited to join the church healing group and given the SNU Healing Committee Application for Registration form to complete, which must be signed by yourself and the Secretary to the Church, you will then send this off to the SNU Healing Committee along with your registration fee. Costs and fees are covered within this leaflet.

## Registration with Healing Committee

Nobody can be registered with the SNU Healing Committee as a trainee healer, if they are not a member or associate member of an SNU affiliated Church or Healing Centre or do not hold Class B membership of the SNU.

The SNU Healing Committee has been established for those healers who practice healing in accordance with the Philosophy and teachings of SNU Spiritualism based on the Seven Principles.

## SNU Healing Code of Conduct and Healing and the Law

SNU healers must work within the regulations of the SNU and there is the obligatory SNU Healing Code of Conduct, which makes Spiritual Healing legally acceptable.

The Code of Conduct states what a healer may or may not do in order to work within the UK.

The booklet called Healing and the Law relates to healing practices.

There are also rules contained within the 'SNU Rules for Churches' that have to be observed in respect of the appointment of healers and healing practices within the SNU Church or Centre.

## Training

The trainee healer has to undergo a minimum practical training period of 102 weekly sessions. There is a booklet available from the SNU Healing Committee called 'Training Programme for Trainee Healers' which gives more details of the training programme than can be covered here.

Once the trainee has been registered with the SNU Healing Committee, they will be issued with a copy of 'The Training Programme for Trainee Healers', and a logbook in which they will keep a record of their progress and practical training they receive.

Each weekly healing session attended by the trainee will be recorded and the record signed by the supervising approved healer.

During the 102 week training period the trainee healer will be expected to attend at least 4 District Training Sessions.

As well as the 102 weekly practical training sessions there is the Education Course, H1-Basic Healing Course, which has 8 sections:

- SNU Healing Code of Conduct and Healing and the Law
- Development of the Healing Medium
- Forms of Healing
- Attitudes to Patients Responsibilities
- Organisation and Administration
- An Outline of Anatomy
- The Philosophy of Spiritualism
- Spiritulaists' National Union

At the end of each section there is between 2 and 4 questions to answer, which you will send off to your tutor .

## Time limit

There is a time limit of a maximum of 5 years (minimum 100 weeks) to complete the H1 Educational course and the required 102 weeks practical training.

## Upgrading Assessment

Upon completion of your H1 Educational Course and required 100 weeks practical training, you can then apply for upgrading to SNU Approved Healer.

You will be sent a letter from the SNU Healing Committee giving you a date to attend for the Upgrading Assessment at a Church within the SDC.

At the Assessment you will have an interview, which is not assessed, but is to help you feel at ease with your assessors and to explain what is to take place.

There will be an oral question and answer session where you will be asked approximately 10 questions on healing practice, the Code of Conduct, Healing and the Law and the SNU.

There will also be a practical healing session where you will have to give healing to 4 patients within 1 hour.

There are several booklets and leaflets available to purchase from the SNU Healing Committee, at a very reasonable cost, which trainee healers and approved healers alike will find extremely useful.
